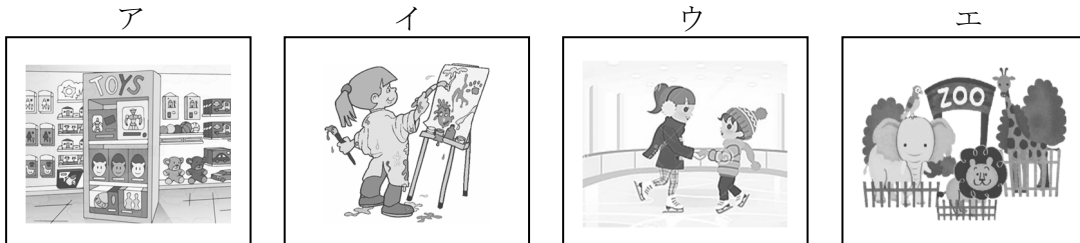

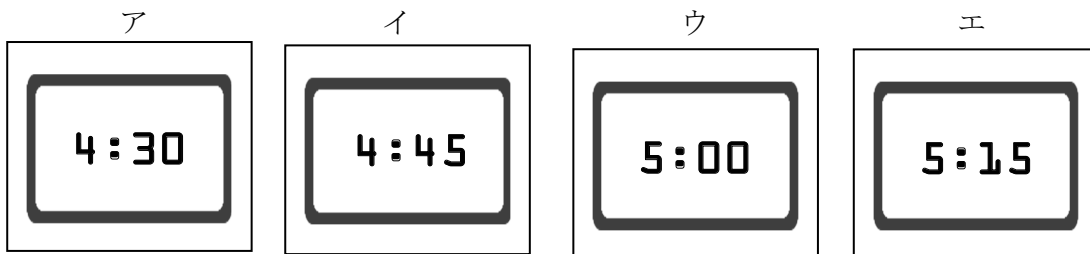

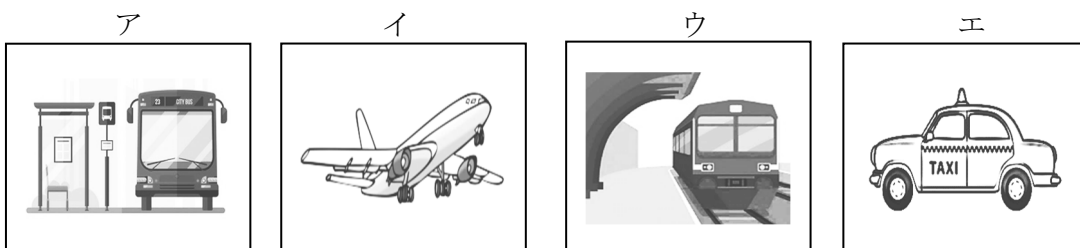

3 次の英文を読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Table tennis is one of the most popular sports in the world. People of all ages can enjoy playing it. You only need a table, two rackets and a ball. There are many players in many countries, especially in Asia. So you may think that this game came from an Asian country, but ①it didn't.

Many people say that table tennis came from England. It started there as an “indoor tennis game” in the 1880s. At that time, tennis was a very popular sport among upper class people. Games were played outside on grass courts. However, there were many rainy days in England. So they wanted to have another game to play inside. A smaller racket and ball were used, and ②(\_\_\_\_)(\_\_\_\_) a court, people played on a table.

Table tennis came to Japan in 1902. A Japanese university professor ③(bring) table tennis rackets and balls to Japan from England. He taught his students how to play the new sport, and they enjoyed playing it. Soon, more and more people got interested in the game. Table tennis became popular very quickly.

Though it is one of the most popular sports in the world, table tennis does not have a long history ④as an Olympic sport. It was played at the Seoul Olympics in 1988 for the first time and Japanese players took part in the games. After that Olympics, ⑤( Japanese people / table tennis / playing / the number / increased / of ) and stronger players appeared.

In 2009, Japan won the men's doubles bronze medal at the World Championships. In 2016, Jun Mizutani won the bronze medal at the Rio de Janeiro Olympic Games. Japan also won the silver medal for the women's team during ⑥those games. Now, Japan has one of the strongest teams in the world. This summer, we will have the Olympic Games in Tokyo. Let's cheer on our national table tennis players!
