

We all know that humans can't live without water. It is said that each person needs to drink at least two liters of water every day to stay healthy. Besides water for drinking, we need water every day for many other purposes such as cooking, taking a bath, and washing clothes.

We also need water to grow food. A lot of water is used for growing vegetables, rice, wheat, and so on. For example, about 2,000 liters of water is used to grow one kilogram of wheat. Farmers raising livestock need a lot of water, too. The water is used to give the livestock drinking water and to grow their feed. About 20,000 liters of water is used to produce one kilogram of beef. From this point of view, when we eat food, we are also consuming "hidden water," the water used in the process of producing food.

Two-thirds of the Earth is water. However, 97.5% of that is seawater, and only 0.01% of the Earth's total water is water we can drink. You probably think that Japan is a country which is rich in water and doesn't have to import it from other countries. But in fact, we import a lot of "water" because we import a lot of food. Now, Japan is one of the world's largest importers of hidden water.

Why do we import so much food? The main reason is that Japanese people's eating habits are changing. We eat only half as much rice as we did sixty years ago. Instead of rice, we eat more bread and noodles. Bread and noodles are made from wheat, and about 85% of that is imported. In addition, we are also eating much more meat compared to the past. About 65% of beef is imported from countries like Australia and the United States.

To reduce the amount of hidden water imported from abroad, we need to reduce food imports. The Japanese government has already taken action. It has set a goal of raising the food self-sufficiency rate from about 40% to 45% by 2030. The government is encouraging people to choose food produced in Japan. It is also encouraging us to eat more meals made with rice and vegetables. This is because the self-sufficiency for these foods is quite high. If we take these actions, we can reduce the amount of food and hidden water we

import. It is necessary for us to remember that our everyday meals are not only related to food itself, but also to water, the limited resource we all have to share.
