

Fika is the Swedish tradition of taking a break to enjoy coffee and a chat. Swedish people of all ages <u>have enjoyed</u> this tradition for many years. But fika is more than just a coffee break; it is a time to relax and connect with others.

The word "fika" ②()() the Swedish word for coffee, "kaffi."

<u>There are no strict rules about when to enjoy fika</u>. Fika can be enjoyed at

any time of day, but the most (④) times are ten o'clock in the morning and three o'clock in the afternoon. People enjoy fika with friends, family or colleagues; in a café, at work, at school or even at home. During fika, people usually drink coffee or tea and eat pastries, cakes or sandwiches. They may talk about their day, share stories or just spend some relaxing time together. Recently, ⑤()() people outside of Sweden know about fika because this tradition has a positive effect on both work and study. This is because fika helps people relax and reduce stress. Amelia Earhart was born on July 24, 1897 in Kansas, the United States. She had a younger sister, Muriel. They enjoyed lots of outdoor activities when they were children. Their mother encouraged them to spend time climbing trees, playing baseball and soccer, and collecting insects and frogs.

When Amelia was in high school, her family moved to Chicago. And in 1916, after she graduated from high school, she became a nurse. She took care of the injured soldiers from World War I in Toronto, Canada. Later, she studied to become a mechanic, but soon she began to study for a career in medical research.

In 1920, Amelia and her father visited an air show in California. There, she rode in a small plane with a pilot for the first time. The flight was for only ten minutes but it changed her life. She decided to become a pilot. So Amelia got several jobs and used the money that she earned to pay for flying lessons. After lots of training, she learned to fly, and eventually got her pilot's license. Amelia also bought her own plane. It was a yellow airplane and she called it "The Canary."

In October 1922, Amelia flew at an altitude of about 4,300 meters and set a world record for women pilots. In 1928, Amelia was invited to take part in a historic flight across the Atlantic Ocean. Together with the pilot and co-pilot, she flew across the Atlantic Ocean as their navigator. Navigating that flight made Amelia famous but she was not satisfied because she wanted to make the same trip by herself. Four years later, she flew from Canada to Northern Ireland by herself. Three months after that, she also successfully flew from California to New Jersey by herself. And in 1935, she became the first person to fly solo from Hawaii to California. After this, she became even more famous in the United States and received many different awards for her achievements. She wrote three books about her flights and a lot of articles for magazines and newspapers.

As the years went by, Amelia decided to take on a new challenge. Her dream was to fly around the world. In 1937, she started her trip. For about a month, the flights went well. But something terrible happened, and Amelia's plane disappeared. People looked for her and her co-pilot for several weeks, but they were never found. Though no one really knows what happened to Amelia's plane, there have been a lot of stories about her last trip.

Amelia is gone but people still remember her achievements. She once wrote this in a letter: "Women must try to do things as men have tried. When they fail, their failure must be a challenge to others."
